1. A Glimpse at our past

The Society of the Sisters of Charity of Secunderabad Province is a Registered Society under the Public Registration Act, in the year 1963. HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Waking up at 5.30 a.m.

- e. <u>Health Programme</u>: This is required of every student. The preventive Health programme includes physical examination, routine laboratory tests and immunization.; Students must undergo a complete health check up on admission and there after every year.
- f. <u>Membership</u>: SNA / CNGI: All students are required to become active members of the Student Nurses Association (SNA) and the Catholic students are expected additionally to become active members of the Catholic Nurses Guild of India (CNGI).
- g. Ragging: Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college or hostel premises Students (freshers) are expected to inform the Principal / Warden in case of such occurrences. Eligibility:

The College admits female and male candidates

- Minimum educational qualification is B.Sc. Nursing / Post Certificate B.Sc. Nursing Degree of University of Health Sciences, Telangana or any other Universities with a minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- The candidate should be registered with the A.P. Nursing Council / T.S. / any State Nursing Registration Council.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing. Text books & Stationery: At student's own expenses.
- Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic **B.Sc.** Nursing.
- Single or married candidates are eligible for admission
- Every selected candidate before admission to the programme will submit a medical fitness certificate from the designated doctor.
- The candidates upper age limit is 45 years.

A. Admission Requirements:

Admission is open to all candidates who fulfil the following requirements:

- 1. The institution admits only unmarried female candidates for the four years B.Sc. Nursing course.
- 2. The candidates should have completed 17 years of age and should not be more than 25 years as on 31st December of the year of admission.
- 3. Minimum educational qualification is a pass in Intermediate Examination or Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12) years course) or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2) or an equivalent with 12 years of schooling from a recognized Institution under a recognized University with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) as subjects. (The equivalence is determined only by the University of Health Sciences, Telangana State) with 45% marks in science subjects, for B.C, Sc & ST 40% and others as per Govt. rules.
- 4. Candidates awaiting Intermediate / II PUC results are also eligible to take the application
- 5. The candidates should possess good health and character.
- Being an Institution run by the minorities with a minority statu preference is given to candidates belonging to Christian minori
- 7. The candidates should submit an application to the Princip College of Nursing in the prescribed form.
